As we move towards the Southwest Fuel & Convenience Expo, June 6-8, we are taking action to create a safe and secure show experience. That action comes in collaboration with the Fort Worth Convention Center, a state entity with extraordinary depth of knowledge on how to maintain a safe and secure trade show environment, and with direct access to the most up-to-date state guidance. Our close collaboration also extends to all show partners and vendors, which continue to follow a rigorous safety regimen.

Here is what we are doing to protect your health and peace of mind so you can safely exhibit and meet with Texas industry leaders.



## Temperature Checks

Daily temperature checks are required for everyone before entering into the exhibit hall.



## Face Masks

Everyone is required to wear face masks in the exhibit hall and all events, unless ordinance changes.



## Hand Sanitizer Stations

Located in the exhibit hall next to the columns and throughout the event.



## Social Distancing

We encourage following the social distancing measures, which recommends for 6 feet of physical distance between individuals.



## Enhanced Safety Measures

Sneeze guards, physical distance dividers, and gloves are encouraged at your booth, with the highest priority to food & beverage handlers.



## Enhanced Cleaning

Before, during and after our event, we will be working with venue partners to ensure the highest standards of hygiene and cleanliness in the public areas.



## Conversation Pods

The Members Pavilion will have appropriately spaced seating.



## Emergency Protocols

An isolation room staffed by an EMT for safety measures will be available at the convention center.
